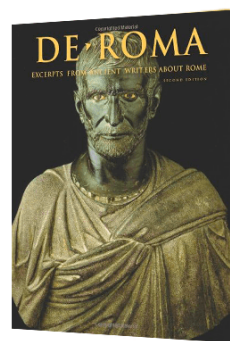
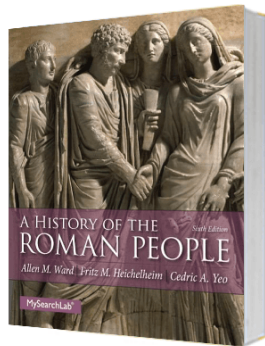


## Books
