douloi	slaves

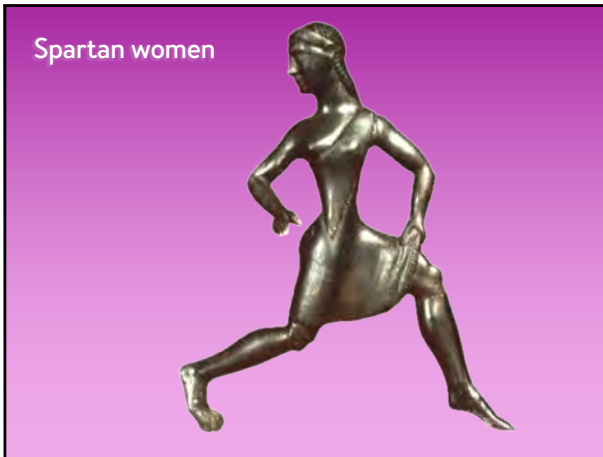

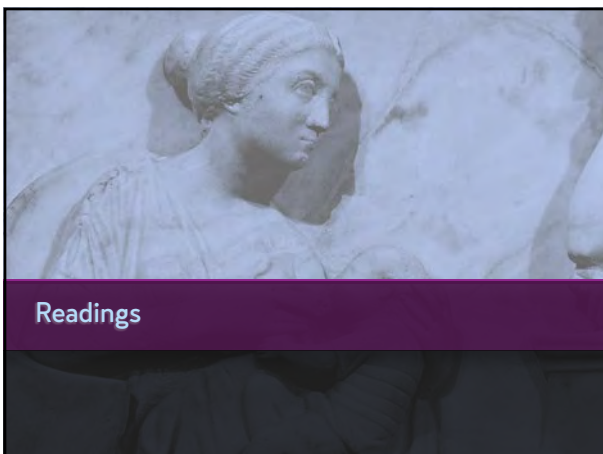

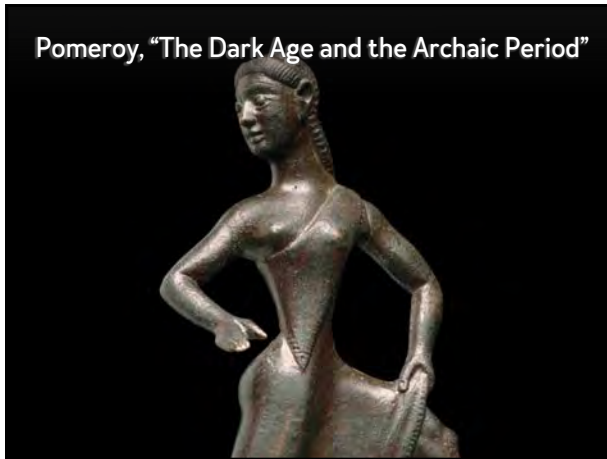
