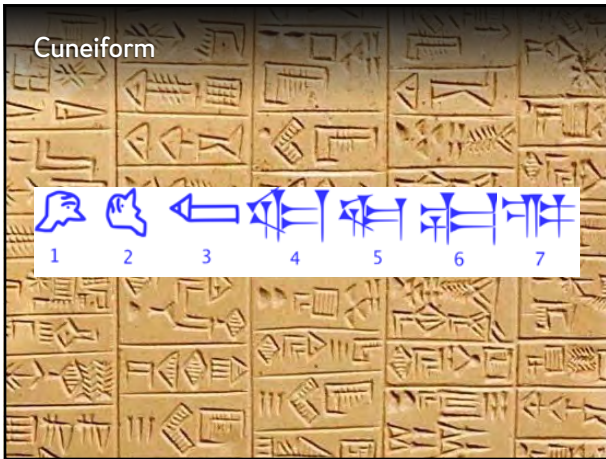
Writing tends to emerge and evolve differently with each urban civilization

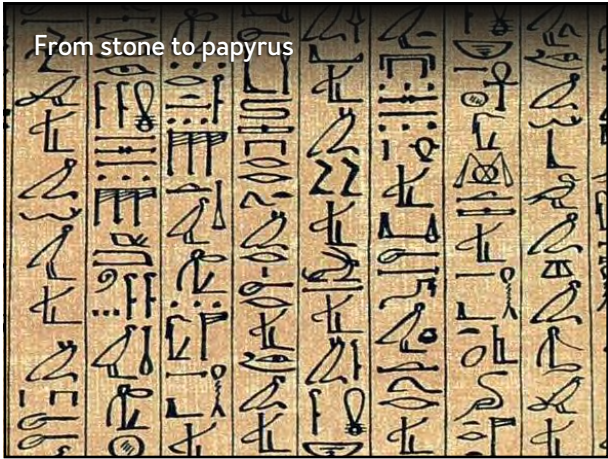

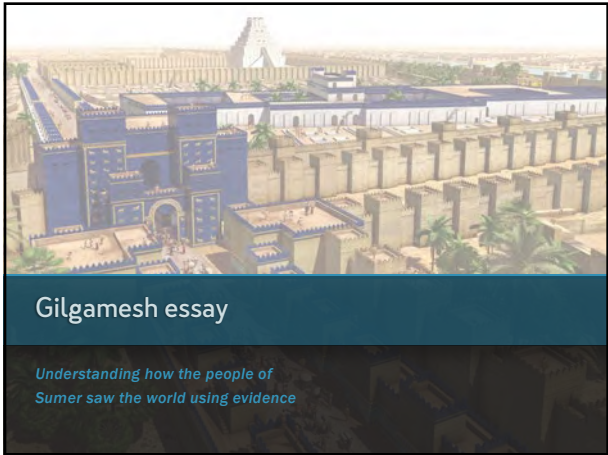

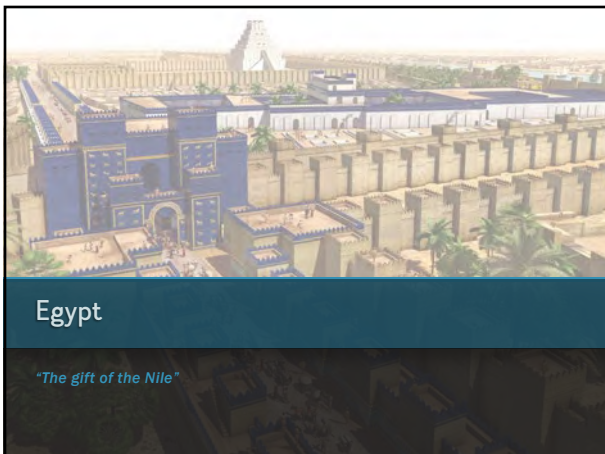

Structure of a position paper

Introduction <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ State the problem (some say ... others say ...)■ Give your thesis (I believe ...)
First reason <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Evidence from primary or secondary sources■ Discussion of how the evidence demonstrates your thesis
Second reason <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Evidence from primary or secondary sources■ Discussion of how the evidence demonstrates your thesis
Third reason <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Evidence from primary or secondary sources■ Discussion of how the evidence demonstrates your thesis
Conclusion <ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Address counterarguments■ Connect your "reason" sections together■ Restate your thesis as having been demonstrated
