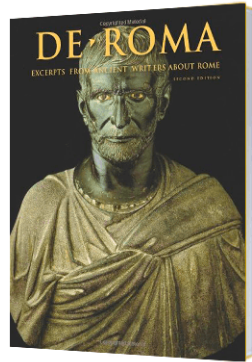
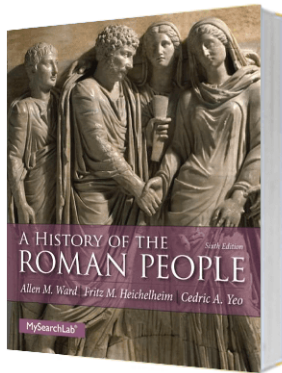


# BOOKS
