Maritime terms, words for the sea, shipping • (a.g. @ddanaa tholassa "sea")
Words relating to Mediterranean agriculture • (a.g. ρίλαΙα (w)elaia *cliva*, άμπελος ampelos *vine*)
Words regarding rulers, given by the populace • (e.g. Túpawor Tyrannas "syrant"; pavaš wanax (warrior-king")
Building technology • (α.g. πύργος ργησος "tower")
Personal names and theonyms • (ap. Obversit; Odyssus) • (ap. Feyth-Hamse)
Place names - nth (ag. KlyperBey Korinthos, ZilaavBey Zokynthos) - ac (ag. BlyperBedy Pointcason) - tt. (a.g. Assurightrios () klabbliotis)




