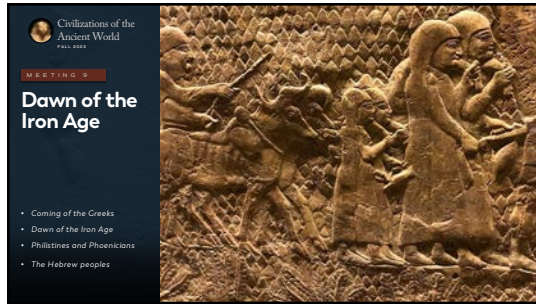
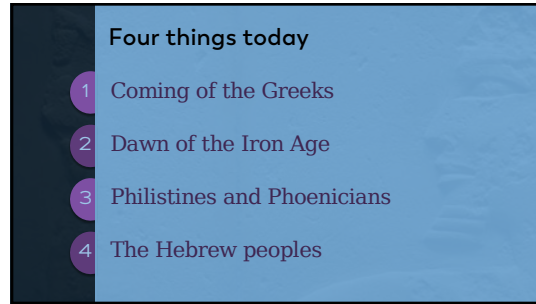




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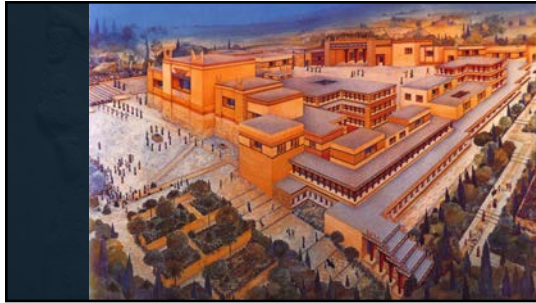

- Maritime terms, words for the sea, shipping
 - (e.g. θάλασσα thalassa "sea")
- Words relating to Mediterranean agriculture
 - (e.g. ἐλαια (w)elaid "olive", ἀμπέλος ampelos "vine")
- Words regarding rulers, given by the populace
 - (e.g. τυραννός tyrannos "tyrant", βασις basileus "warrior-king")
- Building technology
 - (e.g. πύργος pyrgos "tower")
- Personal names and theonyms
 - (e.g. Οδυσσεύς Odysseus)
 - (e.g. Ἑρμῆς Hermes)
- Place names
 - -ντιν- (e.g. Κανίνας Caninthus, Ζάκυνθος Zakynthos)
 - -σσ- (e.g. Παρνασσός Parnassos)
 - -ττ- (e.g. Λυκαβηττός Lykabettos)
